

Who is not suitable for Semi Permanent Makeup?

- AIDS
- Active skin disorders: Pink eye, psoriasis, warts, active herpes simplex. Wait until the condition clears.
- Allergy: Nickel (found in the needle) or Lidocaine. Anyone who suffers with any other allergies will need a prior patch test.
- Blood disorders: Sickle cell anemia, hemophilia, patients taking anti-coagulant medications such as Coumadin, Heparin, or large doses of Aspirin. Obtain permission from your doctor to discontinue use of medication prior to the procedure.
- Cancer or Chemotherapy: Please consult your doctor.
- Diabetes: Patients with full blown diabetes will not heal well and are more prone to infection. We require a doctors release prior to your procedure.
- Hepatitis B/C: Are highly infectious. A person who has had the disease will always harbour the virus in their blood.
- High Blood Pressure: Please check with your doctor.
- Keloid Scarring: Work is not performed on those whose scars have ever heal badly, raised or are known to suffer from keloids.
- Lupus: Patients with lupus are not good candidates because of their healing and clotting.
- Pregnancy or Breastfeeding mothers.
- Any other medical conditions: If you have a medical condition or are taking regular medication please do consult your own doctor before booking. It is ALWAYS worth checking beforehand.
